

**CITY COUNCIL MEETING
1-20-21**

The City Council of the City of Lineville met in their regular meeting on Wednesday, January 20, 2021, at 5:00 p.m. at the City Annex Building in Lineville, Alabama, with the following present: Mayor Roy Adamson, Council Members: Carolyn Smith, David Proctor, Joseph Appleby, Robert Milstead and Larry Bishop, Chief Shane Dunnagan, City Clerk Donna Mathews, Assistant City Clerk Nicholas New and Tammy Andrews from the Clay Times Journal. City Supervisor Rusty Taylor was absent from the meeting.

Mayor called the meeting to order. Mayor asked the Council if they had reviewed the minutes from the previous Council meeting. A motion was then made by Council Member David Proctor and seconded by Council Member Carolyn Smith to approve the minutes from the previous meeting. The vote was unanimous. Next the Mayor asked the Council if they had reviewed the bills to be paid. A motion was then made by Council Member Joseph Appleby and seconded by Council Member Larry Bishop to approve the bills to be paid. The vote was unanimous.

Tiffany Young from the Chamber of Commerce was present to give an update on the upcoming events in the County. The Spring Fair dates will be announced tomorrow. The Junior Chamber is starting again in February and the Annual Chamber Dinner has been postponed at this time.

First on the agenda was the bid opening on maintenance shed. Mayor had opened the hearing at 4:30 p.m. and closed it at 5:03 p.m. for the bids. Due to the absence of City Supervisor Rusty Taylor any announcements pertaining to the bids will be held Monday, February 1, 2021.
