

**CITY COUNCIL MEETING**  
**9-9-20**

The City Council of the City of Lineville met in their regular meeting on Monday, September 9, 2020 at the Annex Building in Lineville, Alabama, with the following present: Mayor Roy Adamson, Council Members: Carolyn Smith, Robert Milstead, Joseph Appleby, and Sarah Appleby, Chief Shane Dunnagan, City Clerk Donna Mathews, Assistant Clerk Nicholas New, City Supervisor Rusty Taylor, and Ray Stansell from the Clay Times Journal. Council Member David Proctor was absent from the meeting.

Mayor called the meeting to order. Mayor asked the Council if they had reviewed the minutes from the previous meeting. A motion was then made by Council Member Carolyn Smith and seconded by Council Member Sarah Appleby to approve the minutes from the previous meeting. The vote was unanimous. Mayor also asked the Council if they had reviewed the minutes from the Canvassing meeting of the election. A motion was then made by Council Member Joseph Appleby and seconded by Council Member Carolyn Smith to approve the minutes from the Canvassing meeting. The vote was unanimous. Next the Mayor asked the Council if they had reviewed the bills to be paid. A motion was then made by Council Member Robert Milstead and seconded by Council Member Sarah Appleby. The vote was unanimous.

First on the agenda was to appoint Debbie Whatley to the vacancy of the Library Board. A motion was then made by Council Member Carolyn Smith and seconded by Council Member Joseph Appleby. The vote was unanimous.

Next was Resolution 9-9-2020-1 read aloud by City Clerk Donna Mathews to make Tier II employees have the same benefits as the Tier I employees. Tier I rates will not be affected by this change. Rate increases will be adjusted for Tier II and employer. A motion was then made by Council Member Carolyn Smith and seconded by Council Member Robert Milstead. The vote was unanimous.

Next was Resolution 9-9-2020-2 read aloud by City Clerk Donna Mathews authorizing Clay County Revenue Commissioner Ronald Robertson to collect the property tax for the City in the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2020. A motion was then made by Council Member Carolyn Smith and seconded by Council Member Sarah Appleby. The vote was unanimous.

Mayor Adamson reminded that budget time is near and we will be voting on the budget at the first meeting in October. Please get everything turned in to Donna.

Last item on the agenda was the Mayor requested the Council grant him permission to open and close the park as allowed by CDC guidelines without having to wait until meeting time. A motion was then made by Council Member Joseph Appleby and seconded by Council Member Robert Milstead. The vote was unanimous. Mayor said we have been fortunate at the City with this Covid thing. Stay vigilant and be safe. Don't get lax now.

There being no further business, a motion to adjourn was then made by Council Member Robert Milstead and seconded by Council Member Sarah Appleby. The vote was unanimous. The meeting ended at 5:10 p.m.
