

**COUNCIL MEETING**  
**10-19-20**

The City Council of the City of Lineville met in their regular meeting on Monday, October 19, 2020, at 5:00 p.m. at the City Annex Building in Lineville, Alabama, with the following present: Mayor Roy Adamson, Council Members: Carolyn Smith, David Proctor, Joseph Appleby, Robert Milstead, and Sarah Appleby, City Clerk Donna Mathews, City Supervisor Rusty Taylor, Assistant Clerk Nicholas New, Lt. Chief Shane Dunnagan was absent from the meeting.

Mayor called the meeting to order. Mayor asked the Council if they had reviewed the minutes from the previous meeting. A motion was then made by Council Member David Proctor and seconded by Council member Carolyn Smith to approve the minutes from the previous meeting. The vote was unanimous.
