

CITY COUNCIL MEETING
2-17-20

The City Council of the City of Lineville met in their regular meeting on Monday, February 17, 2020, at the City Annex Building in Lineville, Alabama, with the following present: Mayor Roy Adamson, Council Members: Carolyn Smith, David Proctor, Robert Milstead, and Sarah Appleby, Chief Shane Dunnagan, City Clerk Donna Mathews, Assistant City Clerk Nicholas New, City Supervisor Rusty Taylor, Keifver Smith from the Clay Times Journal and guest, Graham Lane. Council Member Joseph Appleby was absent from the meeting.

Mayor called the meeting to order. Mayor asked the Council if they had reviewed the minutes from the previous meeting. A motion was then made by Council Member David Proctor and seconded by Council Member Sarah Appleby to approve the minutes from the previous meeting. The vote was unanimous. Next the Mayor asked the Council if they had reviewed the bills to be paid. A motion was then made by Council Member Robert Milstead and seconded by Council Member Carolyn Smith to approve the bills to be paid. The vote was unanimous.

First on the agenda was the adoption of Ordinance Number 2020-02-3-1 on McLeod Annexation which was introduced 2-3-2020 and properly advised in the local paper as required. A motion was then made by Council Member Carolyn Smith and seconded by Council Member David Proctor to adopt said Ordinance. The vote was as follows:

Next on the agenda was the adoption of Ordinance Number 2020-02-3-2 on amending the Alcohol application which was introduced 2-3-2020 and properly advised in the local paper as required. A motion was then made by Council Member Sarah Appleby and seconded by Council Member David Proctor to adopt said Ordinance. The vote was as follows:

Mayor said we need to appoint our Voting Delegate to serve at the League Convention this year. A motion was then made by Council Member Robert Milstead to appoint Council Member Carolyn Smith and was seconded by Council Member David. The vote was unanimous.

Chief Dunnagan asked if he could go ahead and purchase the bullet proof vest that were approved in his budget for \$7200.00 at this time. The cost for the City will be only half of that once we get reimbursed. Our vest at the department now are over 5 years old. A motion was

then made by Council Member David Proctor and seconded by Council Member Robert Milstead. The vote was unanimous.

City Supervisor told the Council that his employee, Nathan Walker's 6 month probation was now up and that he had done a good job for the City. He recommended him to be hired on as a full time employee and move his pay status up to the first step on the pay scale off probation. A motion was then made by Council Member Robert Milstead and seconded by Council Member David Proctor. The vote was unanimous.

Chief Shane Dunnagan told the Council that his employee, Tabitha Harris' 6 month probation was now up and that she had done a good job as a dispatcher. He made a recommendation that the City hire her on as a full time employee and raise her pay status to the first step on the pay scale off probation. A motion was then made by Council Member Carolyn Smith and seconded by Council Member Robert Milstead. The vote was unanimous.

Mayor reminded the Council that we had added an item to the agenda in the work session for Mayor and Council salaries. Ordinance 2020-02-17-1 raises the Mayor's salary to \$1000.00 per month and the Council Member's salaries to \$400.00 per month. A motion was made by Council Member David Proctor and seconded by Council Member Robert Milstead to introduce the Ordinance. The vote was as follows:

Mayor talked about the water issues and flooding everyone is having and said our maintenance department are doing a good job and having no major issues. City Supervisor Rusty Taylor said we lost the shoulder of Bradford Street but repaired it and other than that it has been small issues. Rusty also gave a baseball signup report and said it ends today with a count at this point of 320. Saturday and Sunday he will be attending the State Babe Ruth/Cal Ripkin training. Lineville will host something this year at some level not sure at this time. Council Member Carolyn Smith asked if the ballfields are okay to be on and Rusty said yes they are right now. Rusty said that the Jr. High is using the #1 field and it is good.

Council Member David Proctor thanked the Merchants Association for the Valentine Event and said they did a good job and it was a great success. Mayor agreed.

Mayor Adamson recognized Graham Lane for being there and said he had been appointed to the Economic Development Council of Clay County. Graham Lane said that they had just recently hired Lamar Dewberry part-time to help develop the growth of Clay County.

After no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by Council Member Robert Milstead and seconded by Council Member Sarah Appleby. The vote was unanimous. The meeting was adjourned at 5:22 p.m.
