

JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 4-6-2020-1

AFFIRMING SUPPORT OF HEALTH ORDERS ISSUED BY ALABAMA DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH RELATING TO THE NOVEL CORONAVIRUS COVID-19 OUTBREAK

WHEREAS, on March 13th Governor Kay Ivey declared a state public health emergency exists in the State of Alabama; and

WHEREAS, on March 25th the first individual located in Clay County Alabama tested positive for the novel coronavirus COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the number of individuals in Clay County testing positive for coronavirus has now increased to two and is expected to continue to increase; and

WHEREAS, the Clay County Commission and the Ashland and Lineville City Council and Mayors are working diligently to implement procedures that will prevent the spread of coronavirus in Clay County; and

WHEREAS, the Alabama Department of Public Health has issued orders restricting the size of public gatherings and ordering the closure of certain non-essential businesses in Alabama.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Clay County Commission, The Ashland City Council and Mayor, and the Lineville City Council and Mayor, that we fully support the actions of the governor of the State of Alabama and the Alabama Department of Public Health to stop the spread of coronavirus in our county and our state.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that we, the commission, city council, and mayors, will use the resources available to ensure compliance with the orders issued to date by the Alabama Department of Public Health and the governor of the State of Alabama.
