

**CITY COUNCIL MEETING**  
**8-17-20**

The City Council of the City of Lineville met in their regular meeting on Monday, August 17, 2020 at the City Annex Building in Lineville, Alabama, with the following present: Mayor Roy Adamson, Council Members: Carolyn Smith, Joseph Appleby, Robert Milstead and David Proctor, Sarah Appleby, Chief Shane Dunnagan, City Clerk Donna Mathews, Assistant Clerk Nicholas New, City Supervisor Rusty Taylor.

Mayor called the meeting to order. Mayor asked the Council if they had reviewed the minutes from the previous meeting. A motion was then made by Council Member David Proctor and seconded by Council Member Carolyn Smith to approve the minutes from the previous meeting. The vote was unanimous. Next the Mayor asked the Council if they had reviewed the bills to be paid. A motion was then made by Council Member Joseph Appleby and seconded by Council Member Robert Milstead to approve the bills to be paid. The vote was unanimous.

First on the agenda was the need to set a meeting on September 1, 2020 at 12:00 noon to canvass the votes from the election. A motion was then made by Council Member Carolyn Smith and seconded by Council Member Sarah Appleby. The vote was unanimous.

Quarterly financials were reviewed and discussed and a motion was then made by Council Member David Proctor and seconded by Council Member Carolyn Smith to accept financials as presented. The vote was unanimous.

Mayor Adamson said that the Labor Day holiday falls on Monday, September 7<sup>th</sup> this year and that is our regular meeting date so we will need to change the date from 9/7/20 to 9/9/20 at regular time. A motion was then made by Council Member Joseph Appleby and seconded by Council Member Robert Milstead. The vote was unanimous.

City Supervisor Rusty Taylor recommended to the Council to hire Christian Fierros as Operator I. He lives in Lineville and is 23 years old. A motion was then made by Council Member Robert Milstead and seconded by Council Member Joseph Appleby. The vote was unanimous.

Mayor Adamson said there is lots of things going on right now such as the election, schools starting back and the City will keep everything as safe as we can and we urge everyone to go out and vote Tuesday, August 25.

City Supervisor Rusty Taylor announced that we will forego soccer this season. Youth football has also been cancelled. Mayor Adamson said that he and Rusty will also be meeting with the Clay County Shriners on August 31<sup>st</sup> to see if they are going to proceed with the annual car

show. Council Member Carolyn Smith said that the Merchants Association will also be deciding if they will have the annual Heritage Day this year.

After no further business, a motion to adjourn was then made by Council Member Robert Milstead and seconded by Council Member Sarah Appleby. The vote was unanimous. The meeting ended at 5:10 p.m.
