

**CITY COUNCIL MEETING
1-4-21**

The City Council of the City of Lineville met in their regular meeting on Monday, January 4, 2021, at 5:00 p.m. at the City Annex Building in Lineville, Alabama, with the following present: Mayor Roy Adamson, Council Members: Carolyn Smith, David Proctor, Joseph Appleby, Robert Milstead and Larry Bishop, Chief Shane Dunnagan, City Supervisor Rusty Taylor, Assistant City Clerk Nicholas New and Ray Stansell from the Clay Times Journal. City Clerk Donna Mathew was absent from the meeting.

Mayor called the meeting to order. Mayor asked the Council if they had reviewed the minutes from the previous Council meeting. A motion was then made by Council Member David Proctor and seconded by Council Member Robert Milstead to approve the minutes from the previous meeting. The vote was unanimous. Next the Mayor asked the Council if they had reviewed the bills to be paid.
