

**COUNCIL MEETING
2-1-2021**

The City Council of the City of Lineville met in their regular meeting on Monday, February 1, 2021, at 5:00 p.m. at the City Annex Building in Lineville, Alabama, with the following present: Mayor Roy Adamson, Council Members: Carolyn Smith, David Proctor, Joseph Appleby, Robert Milstead and Larry Bishop, Chief Shane Dunnagan, City Clerk Donna Mathews, Assistant City Clerk Nicholas New, City Supervisor Rusty Taylor and Ray Stansell from the Clay Times Journal.

Mayor called the meeting to order. Mayor asked the Council if they had reviewed the minutes from the previous Council meeting. A motion was then made by Council Member David Proctor and seconded by Council Member Carolyn Smith to approve the minutes from the previous meeting. The vote was unanimous. Next the Mayor asked the Council if they had reviewed the bills to be paid. A motion was then made by Council Member Joseph Appleby and seconded by Council Member Robert Milstead to approve the bills to be paid. The vote was unanimous.

First item on the agenda was the Bid announcement from the previous meeting. Only 1 bid was received from Hurst Construction in the amount of \$44,900.00. A motion was then made by Council Member Robert Milstead and seconded by Council Member David Proctor to accept bid. The vote was unanimous.

Next on the agenda was to adopt Ordinance 2021-01-20-1 Agriculture Zoning for the property annexed in from the Olive Branch Community. A motion was then made by Council Member Carolyn Smith and seconded by Council Member David Proctor. The vote was unanimous.

A special edition magazine is being published by the Clay Times Journal for the Clay County Christian Academy Eagles and ½ page ad will cost \$300.00. A motion was then made by Council Member Robert Milstead and seconded by Council Member Carolyn Smith. The vote was unanimous. Council Member David Proctor abstained from the vote.

The Clay County Chamber contract is due for the year for \$5400.00 to the City to be paid in 2 payments of \$2700.00. The Council discussed the current board members and said that there is one (1) opening for Lineville to appoint and fill the vacancy. Council Member Carolyn Smith said it is very important for us to know who is on the board and who is representing us as a City. She further stated that the Chamber must work with both Mayors and City Councils. A motion was then made by Council Member Carolyn Smith and seconded by Council Member Joseph Appleby to renew contract with the Chamber. The vote was unanimous.

Mayor Adamson commented on what a long day Lineville Fire Department had at the last fire and how well they all worked.

City Supervisor Rusty Taylor gave an update on ball sign up. They will be Monday, February 8, from 6-8 and Saturday, February 13 from 9-11 and Monday, February 15 from 6-8. In order to hold a safe sign up we will be doing them through the drive-thru window at the Lineville City Hall. Also, the State meeting should be sometime this month.

Council Member David Proctor echoed the Mayor on commending the Lineville Fire Department and what an outstanding job they did for 3 hours. That makes 3 house fires already in 2021 and we didn't even have 3 total in 2020.

There being no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by Council Member Robert Milstead and seconded by Council Member Larry Bishop. The vote was unanimous. The meeting ended at 5:24 p.m.
