

CITY COUNCIL MEETING
7-20-20

The City Council of the City of Lineville met in their regular meeting on Monday, July 20, 2020 at the City Annex Building in Lineville, Alabama, with the following present: Mayor Roy Adamson, Council Members: Carolyn Smith, Joseph Appleby, Robert Milstead and David Proctor, Chief Shane Dunnagan, City Clerk Donna Mathews, City Supervisor Rusty Taylor, and Madilyn Wolf from the Clay Times Journal. Council Member Sarah Appleby was absent.

Mayor called the meeting to order. Mayor asked the Council if they had reviewed the minutes from the previous meeting. A motion was then made by Council Member David Proctor and seconded by Council Member Carolyn Smith to approve the minutes from the previous meeting. The vote was unanimous. Next the Mayor asked the Council if they had reviewed the bills to be paid. Next on the agenda was to do a lease for a lot on the old swimming pool property with Tank New for his food trailer business Big Boy Wings for \$25.00 per month for a lot. A motion was then made by Council Member Robert Milstead and seconded by Council Member David Proctor. The vote was unanimous.

Mayor Adamson thanked everyone for wearing masks. We've had a couple of employees that had to quarantine and be out for 14 days due to being exposed. We ask that everyone be careful and continue to comply with State guidelines.

Council Member David Proctor said the park golf tournament was very successful. They had to turn away 4 teams and next year they are going to look at doing it in 2 parts. He also thanked all the fire departments for their assistance Saturday and the people who volunteered and brought water and Gatorade to the scene of the house fire.
