

**CITY COUNCIL MEETING**  
**3-16-2020**

The City Council of the City of Lineville met in their regular meeting on Monday, March 16, 2020, at the City Annex Building in Lineville, Alabama, with the following present: Mayor Roy Adamson, Council Members: Carolyn Smith, David Proctor, Joseph Appleby, Robert Milstead, and Sarah Appleby, Chief Shane Dunnagan, City Clerk Donna Mathews, Assistant City Clerk Nicholas New, and City Supervisor Rusty Taylor.

Mayor called the meeting to order. Mayor asked the Council if they had reviewed the minutes from the previous meeting. A motion was then made by Council Member David Proctor and seconded by Council Member Sarah Appleby to approve the minutes from the previous meeting. The vote was unanimous. Next the Mayor asked the Council if they had reviewed the bills to be paid. Mayor Adamson reminded everyone to stay safe and follow all the guidelines during this time of COVID-19.

City Supervisor Rusty Taylor said the ball season will happen as long as we can get it in before the fall season gets here.

After no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by Council Member Robert Milstead and seconded by Council Member Sarah Appleby. The vote was unanimous. The meeting adjourned at 5:08 p.m.
