

CITY COUNCIL MEETING
8-3-20

The City Council of the City of Lineville met in their regular meeting on Monday, August 3, 2020 at the City Annex Building in Lineville, Alabama, with the following present: Mayor Roy Adamson, Council Members: Carolyn Smith, Joseph Appleby, Robert Milstead and David Proctor, Sarah Appleby, Chief Shane Dunnagan, City Clerk Donna Mathews, Assistant Clerk Nicholas New, City Supervisor Rusty Taylor, Madilyn Wolf from the Clay Times Journal and guests Michael and Gloria Smith.

Mayor called the meeting to order. Mayor asked the Council if they had reviewed the minutes from the previous meeting. A motion was then made by Council Member David Proctor and seconded by Council Member Carolyn Smith to approve the minutes from the previous meeting. The vote was unanimous. Next the Mayor asked the Council if they had reviewed the bills to be paid. A motion was then made by Council Member Joseph Appleby and seconded by Council Member Robert Milstead to approve the bills to be paid. The vote was unanimous.

First on the agenda was Resolution 8-3-2020-1 for a certificate of election for Council Member Carolyn Smith. City Clerk Donna Mathews read the resolution into the minutes. Next on the agenda was Resolution 8-3-2020-3 for the election officers. City Clerk Donna Mathews read the resolution into the minutes. A motion to adopt Resolution 8-3-2020-2 was then made by Council Member Robert Milstead and seconded by Council Member Carolyn Smith. The vote was unanimous.

Next was the election officers pay. A motion to pay the election officers who work the day of the election was \$100.00 and \$125.00 for the Chief Inspector and Return Officer was then made by Council Member Sarah Appleby and seconded by Council Member Carolyn Smith. The vote was unanimous.

City Supervisor Rusty Taylor presented a resignation from Nathan Walker in the maintenance department to be effective August 7, 2020. A motion to accept his resignations was then made by Council Member David Proctor and seconded by Council Member Joseph Appleby. The vote was unanimous.

A motion was then made to open the position of Operator I and leave it open until position is filled by Council Member Robert Milstead and seconded by David Proctor. The vote was unanimous.

Chief Shane Dunnagan reported to the Council that Dispatcher Stephanie Jones 6 month probation ended and he recommends at this time to place her in the position full time and move her to the next step of pay after probation. A motion was then made by Council Member Carolyn Smith and seconded by Council Member Sarah Appleby. The vote was unanimous.

Mayor reminded everyone again to take all the precautions that you could to stay safe from COVID. He thanked the visitors, Michael and Gloria Smith for coming to the meeting.

After no further business, a motion to adjourn was then made by Council Member Robert Milstead and seconded by Joseph Appleby. The vote was unanimous. The meeting was adjourned at 5:19 p.m.
